Dear Parent/Carer

It is disappointing we are back in this situation. I think we all hoped to have more normality by this time. My thoughts are very much with all of you as we struggle to navigate the restrictions placed on the country as a whole.

Gleniffer High is operating a hub provision for children of keyworkers, which opened on 7th January. From Monday 11th January, remote learning will begin.

This week, departments pulled together information which details how work will be delivered, how pupils should submit work and how feedback will take place. This will look different in every department and even within departments. This document summarises key information for you.

Weekly tracking of pupil engagement in learning will take place and senior leaders will make contact with home to offer support if young people are struggling to access or complete work. Pupil Support Teachers and ASNAs will also be on hand to offer help.

It is vital during this lockdown period that we continue to move learning on. Young people will be expected to be available at set times in the week (information will come from their own teachers) to go over the work of the class and get feedback. However, we also recognise the need for flexibility to meet the demands of remote learning and the impact on home. If you or your child have concerns about their workload or how to manage it across the week, please contact the school office and someone will get in touch to help.

I would recommend having a look through the Digital Learning section of our school website, which gives information on how to access different digital platforms. Please also note our Pastoral Support Team will be issuing PSE materials to support mindfulness, wellbeing and study habits which should prove very useful in the coming weeks.

I very much hope this period of remote learning doesn't last too long and welcome any feedback, which helps us to offer the best provision we can.

Hints and Tips

- Try to stick to a normal sleep pattern and look at each day as a normal school day.
- As work becomes available each day plan out what you are going to complete and **check when you need to be available to interact with teachers.**
- If you are stuck with a question or task, **message your teacher** and carry on with the next piece of work. **You must ask for help.**
- If you feel overwhelmed with the amount of work, **contact your teacher and arrange a suitable deadline.** We understand this is a more difficult way to work.
- Build in breaks after each task you complete and remember to take breaks for snacks and lunch. Try to go for a walk and get some fresh air throughout your day.
- Pupils who normally get support from the hub will have pupil support staff as well as their class teachers on hand to help with work being set so don't hesitate to **message your link person** (they will be in touch with you next week) as well as your class teacher for help.
- Teachers will be tracking your progress with work and making weekly returns to the Head Teacher. **We will follow up with any pupils** who seem to be struggling to get work completed, to see how we can help.
