Exam Exceptional Circumstance

Eligibility – unable to sit exam on day bereavement medical condition Covid domestic circumstance exceptional absence

Candidates must have completed the course All non exam components completed Estimate submitted Evidence submitted to SQA



Exam Exceptional Circumstance

- No Appeal process for EEC candidates
- Candidates must consent to EEC
- SQA look at demonstrated evidence against National standard



Appeals 2022

- Free Appeals process
- Awarded grade needs to be lower than Estimated grade
- Evidence based
