Advanced Higher RMPS Course

What will I be learning?

In Advanced Higher, you will attend RMPS six periods per week and will study the following topic areas:

- Philosophy of Religion
 - Cosmological Argument
 - Teleological Argument
 - Atheism
- Medical Ethics
 - Beginning of Life
 - Organ Transplants
 - End of Life
- Dissertation

How will I be assessed?

All topics in the Advanced Higher RMPS course have a tracking activity at the end of the unit. You will also be working towards your dissertation, researching a complex religious, moral or philosophical question of your own choice.

These tasks help you demonstrate knowledge, analysis and evaluation of complex philosophical arguments and concepts, moral debates and responses to these.

Your teacher will hold regular learning conversations with you, so that you know how you are progressing and how to improve your performance.

You will also have a prelim in January followed by a second prelim once the delivery of the course is complete.

What does homework look like?

You will receive at least one piece of homework per week.

The homework for Advanced Higher RMPS includes research tasks, example exam questions, source tasks and revision.
