What will I be learning?

In S1, you will attend ICT two periods per week and will study the following topic areas:

- File management
- Using the computer
- Internet safety
- Computer systems
- Word processing
- Presenting information
- Spreadsheets
- Databases
- Intro to programming
- Sustainability

How will I be assessed?

All topics in the S1 ICT course have graded activities. These activities are normally tasks completed on the computer (such as the P7 transition newsletter article in the Word processing topic).

These tasks help you demonstrate your understanding of the topic to your teacher. Your work will be graded at bronze, silver or gold level.

Your teacher will share with you how to achieve each level, so you know how to improve your result on the next task.

Don't worry if you need additional support to complete your assessments - your teacher will organise this for you!

What does homework look like?

You will receive at least one piece of homework per topic.

The homework for ICT is in the form of a multiple-choice quiz on Satchel One.

You have three attempts to complete the quiz, and your best score will be recorded.

See your teacher in class if you need help accessing Satchel One, or if you would prefer to complete the homework on paper instead.
