What will I be learning?

In S1, you will attend RMPS one period per week and will study the following topic areas:

- Ultimate Questions
- An Introduction to Morality
- Whirlwind Tour of Major World Religions
- The Existence of God?
- CSI Jerusalem
- Food and Faith

How will I be assessed?

All topics in the S1 RMPS course have assessment activities. These activities are normally tasks with an element of choice in the final product displaying your learning and skills.

These tasks help you demonstrate knowledge and understanding of different ways of making sense of the world, analysis of this knowledge and the ability to engage with sources. Your work will be graded at bronze, silver or gold level.

Your teacher will share with you how to achieve each level, so you know how to improve your result on the next task.

Don't worry if you need additional support to complete your assessments - your teacher will organise this for you!

What does homework look like?

You will receive at least one piece of homework per topic.

The homework for RMPS is in the form of research tasks, reflection tasks, source tasks and revision for class assessments.

All homework will be issued via Satchel One, please see your teacher in class if you need help accessing Satchel One.
