## S3 Business Course

### What will I be learning?

In S3, you will attend Business for four periods per week and will study the following units:

- Role of Businesses in Society
- Customer Service
- Structures and Decision Making
- Stakeholders
- Marketing
- Operations
- Finance
- Working Practices

In class you will have the opportunity to research a variety of real businesses, bringing to life the content you are exploring. We also support you to develop a wide variety of invaluable skills, such as teamworking and interpersonal skills.

If you are studying Business Skills then you will undertake similar units as above, however we will look to develop these with more of an employability and skills based focus.

### How will I be assessed?

All units in the S3 Business course have tracked activities. These activities are normally tasks completed on the computer (such as creating PowerPoints, posters or reports to demonstrate your knowledge and understanding).

You will receive feedback on your progress from your teacher and a 'grade' of bronze, silver or gold level, to help you understand how you are progressing through the course.

Your teacher will share with you how to achieve each level, so you know how to improve your result on the next task.

Don't worry if you need additional support to complete your assessments – your teacher will organise this for you!

### What does homework look like?

You will receive a variety of different pieces of homework throughout the course.

The homework will be made available on Satchel One, and resources will be uploaded to your class Teams Page for you to refer to if you need some extra support when completing your homework.
