What will I be learning?

In S4, you will attend RMPS one period per week and will study the following topic areas:

- Morality in the News
- Interview with a Believer
- Ethics and the Law
- Ethics and Industry

How will I be assessed?

All topics in the S4 RMPS course have assessment activities. These activities are normally tasks with an element of choice in the final product displaying your learning and skills.

These tasks help you demonstrate your developing understanding of different belief systems, moral and social issues and ethical ideas, analysis and evaluation of scenarios and a demonstration of how to engage with an ever-changing world. Your work will be graded at bronze, silver or gold level.

Your teacher will share with you how to develop your skills, so you know how to improve your result on the next task.

Don't worry if you need additional support to complete your assessments – your teacher will organise this for you!

What does homework look like?

You will receive at least one piece of homework per topic.

The homework for RMPS is in the form of research tasks, reflection tasks, source tasks, project work and presentations.

All homework will be issued via Satchel One, please see your teacher in class if you need help accessing Satchel One.
