What will I be learning?

In S1-S2, you will follow our mathematics course based on Experiences and Outcomes from the Curriculum for Excellence at either Second, Third or Fourth Level.

Our course is arranged into Blocks of three topics. Throughout S1-S2, you will learn a range of different mathematical concepts from Number Process, Time and Measure to Algebra, Statistics and Geometry.

How will I be assessed?

Assessment will be ongoing and take place during each lesson in the form of questioning, checking jotters, exit passes, etc.

We use formal Block Assessments at the end of each block. These will normally take place before school holidays. We aim to give two weeks notice before Block Assessments. Dates will be posted on Satchel One along with revision material. We expect pupils to revise independently at home, as well as completing homework tasks.

Following Block Assessments, pupils complete an evaluation in class, highlighting areas of success and where more revision is required.

What does homework look like?

You will receive a piece of homework once a week. It is important that you keep up with the homework as best you can as regular revision improves overall attainment.

All homework tasks will be posted on Satchel One. The homework is normally practice of recent learning. Most homework assignments should be completed in the class jotter.
